The State of California has mandated that 50% of new residential construction be Net-Zero energy by 2016 and that 100% must be Net-Zero energy by 2020.

Many of us do not build new homes. Most of the construction in the Bay area is remodel. How can Net-Zero energy methods be incorporated in remodels?

We will present an overview of what goes into creating a Net-Zero energy house and then take a closer look at how air to water heat pump systems and solar thermal systems can contribute to Net-Zero energy and how these systems work. Also to consider is the relative costs of the systems and other measures.
